Dr. Hafiza Khan is double board certified in cardiovascular disease and clinical cardiac electrophysiology. She specializes in device implantations, such as pacemakers, implantable defibrillators, and cardiac resynchronization devices. She also has a special interest in arrhythmia in women and the ablation of supraventricular arrhythmias. She is a frequent lecturer on topics such as atrial fibrillation management, sudden death prevention, and ICD therapy.

Patient education is a critical aspect in treating cardiovascular disease. Therefore, Dr. Khan maintains an active presence on social media to educate the public about heart health and tips for a heart-healthy lifestyle as well as choosing the right doctor for their needs.

Dr. Khan graduated from UCLA School of Medicine where she was a member of the Alpha Omega Alpha honor society. She completed her internship and residency at the UC San Francisco School of Medicine and served as chief medical resident at Moffitt-Long Hospital. Dr. Khan went on to complete fellowships in cardiology and clinical cardiac electrophysiology at Brigham and Women's Hospital, a Harvard University hospital in Boston.
