Dr. Paul Pin is chief of plastic surgery at Baylor University Medical Center as well as a clinical assistant professor of surgery at Texas A&M Medical School. Dr. Pin also teaches the plastic surgery residents from UT Southwestern Medical Center.

Dr. Pin has been in solo practice his entire career, and now has a partner. After being in practice for 35 years, he recognizes he cannot practice forever and has wanted someone to take over the care of his patients once he retires.
