Dr. Hall is board certified in heart failure/transplant and is the chief of transplant cardiology at Baylor Scott & White Dallas. Raised on Cape Cod, she got to Texas as quickly as she could and never left. Her entire career has been dedicated to advanced heart failure and transplantation. She serves on multiple national organizations, recently completing her terms as chair of the cardiac committee of the National UNOS Thoracic Committee and chair of the thoracic committee of the American Society of Transplantation. She is now president of the Texas Chapter of the American College of Cardiology, the first woman to hold this role. She has been honored by *D Magazine* nine times as a Best Doctor. Dr. Hall leads the largest transplant program in North Texas and is consistently top 10 in the nation.

Board certified in cardiovascular disease, interventional cardiology, and heart failure/transplant cardiology, Dr. Snyder is president of HeartPlace, the largest independent cardiology practice in Texas. A former president of the medical staff at Medical City Dallas, he has also served on the board of governors for the American College of Cardiology in D.C., as well as president of the Texas Chapter. In 2012, Dr. Snyder was president of the Dallas County Medical Society. He currently serves as chairman of the board of directors for ASPEN Specialty Physician Independent Network, as well as president-elect for the Texas Medical Association. Dr. Snyder has been honored by *D Magazine* 16 times as a Best Doctor. Raised in Dallas, he attended Jesuit and subsequently Notre Dame and remains an avid fan of the Fighting Irish.
