AESTHETIC PLASTIC SURGERY

Dr. Bryan Armijo, a board-certified and fellowship-trained plastic surgeon, became interested in plastic surgery during medical school after seeing how his grandmother was faced with the complexities of navigating life after breast cancer. Successful breast reconstruction wasn't common then, and Dr. Armijo didn't like watching her struggle through the illness and life post mastectomy. He decided to pursue plastic surgery as a specialty in order to make a meaningful difference in patients' lives. Today, Dr. Armijo is one of only a few plastic surgeons to have completed a highly competitive accredited aesthetic fellowship at UT Southwestern Medical Center. He has a special interest in breast reconstruction, which has prompted him to lead medical panels about the topic as well as author numerous articles and chapters about the surgery.

On the cosmetic side of his practice, Dr. Armijo specializes in breast lifts, reduction, and augmentation in addition to abdominoplasty, the 360-body lift, and body contouring of the arms and thighs. His practice offers the latest modalities for skin tightening, and he is also sought after for his natural-looking results in nonsurgical procedures, including Botox, dermal fillers, microneedling, chemical peels, and laser skin resurfacing in his fully accredited facility. On the reconstruction side of the practice, Dr. Armijo specializes in all aspects of breast reconstruction, from implant-based reconstruction procedures to the DIEP flap surgery, where he takes excess skin and fat from the lower abdomen area and, through microsurgery, transfers the tissues to the breast area to create a soft, natural looking and feeling breast.

Dr. Armijo is also a partner in the EpiCentre Skin Care and Laser Center, which is part of the Dallas Plastic Surgery Institute. He often sends his patients for post-operative endermologie treatments to reduce and resolve post-surgical swelling as well as laser treatments to improve the appearance of their scars. From comprehensive patient care to nutrition counseling, Dr. Armijo and his staff are dedicated to complete patient care. "Our patients receive exemplary care from start to finish, from their initial consultation all the way through their post-operative care," he says. "Both my practice manager and patient coordinator have been with me since day one, which speaks volumes about our team's dedication to our patients and to this practice. I have also been fortunate enough to find and round out my team with an exceptional medical staff, which includes both a certified physician's assistant and medical assistant.
