Dr. Michels is a world-renowned expert in interventional pain medicine. He is a member of the board of directors for the American Society of Pain and Neuroscience and has published multiple articles and book chapters on the diagnosis and treatment of acute and chronic pain. At his practice, his goal is to ensure that pain and injury don't stop his patients from living out their passions in their own lives.

He specializes in using minimally invasive, image-guided techniques to treat acute and chronic pain conditions, including neck and back pain, sciatica, herniated discs, joint pain, spinal stenosis, spinal compression fractures, migraine headaches, peripheral neuropathy, complex regional pain syndrome (CRPS), and sports injuries.

Dr. Michels received his medical degree from the Keck School of Medicine at USC in Los Angeles, where he became a dean's list scholar and member of the medical school admissions committee. He then went to Baylor College of Medicine in Houston to complete a residency in diagnostic radiology and to the University of California, Irvine to complete an ACGME-accredited, multidisciplinary fellowship in interventional pain management. He is double board certified in diagnostic radiology and pain medicine.
